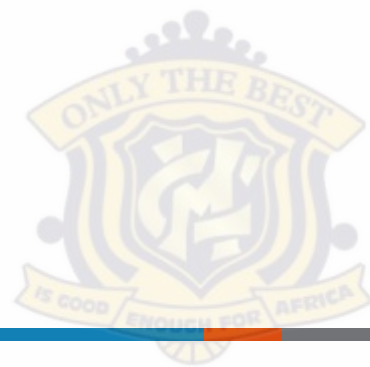
Tuesday, 28 January, 2025: Grand finale and the Founders Day: The children had a rally at the school compound to celebrate the day.

Opening Remarks
